2007 Charles Vineyard "All-In" Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

We used a poker term (all in) to describe this stellar wine — a combination of all of the Pinot Noir clones grown in our estate vineyard. The fruit for this wine was hand-harvested, with our close supervision and involvement (as with all our wines).

The wine was 80% destemmed and fermented with 20% whole clusters and wild yeast. Punch downs were done by hand and malolactic fermentation was completely wild as well. No racking was done while the wine was aged in 100% French oak.

Here at Foursight we're big believers of un-fined and unfiltered Pinot Noirs, and that's exactly what we did with this wine: nothing. We think the strategy paid off—we went all in and ended up with a winning hand, er, wine.

Alcohol: 14.1%

Barrel Aging: 20% first-year barrels, 31.25% two-year-old barrels and 43.75% neutral barrels—a blend of François Frère and Remond cooperages from Allier, Trancas and Bertranges forests
