

## 2009 Charles Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

The 2009 Sauvignon Blanc was harvested from our estate vineyard just outside of Boonville — one of just a few vineyards planted to Sauvignon Blanc in the entire Anderson Valley appellation.

Each year we struggle with this grape, which is more finicky and difficult to grow than our Pinot Noir. However, when the wine is made, we're always glad we went through it all again.

This wine is 100% Sauvignon Blanc, cold-fermented and aged in 100% stainless steel to retain its natural, bright flavors and crisp acidity. In addition to the beautiful citrus and tropic fruit aromas and flavors



found in this wine, it pairs with almost any food, making it an easy addition to the dinner table.
