WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

During our first few years as vintners, we discovered that we love our estate Pommard fruit aged in newer oak barrels, so in 2007 we pulled off four barrels and produced a 100% Pommard clone Pinot Noir aged in 50% new French oak barrels. Our family and our customers enjoyed it so much that we now produce this wine every year.

The 2010 Clone 05 Pinot Noir is our third release of this blend, crafted with the same gentle methods as our other Pinots: hand-harvested, 70% destemmed with 30% whole clusters, hand punch downs, then fermented with wild yeast and wild ML cultures. No racking was done during aging.

We love this limited-production wine for its unique spot in our roster of Pinot Noirs — it's bigger and bolder than our All-In or Zero New Oak, but not over the top. You'll taste the toasty oak and spice alongside pure red fruit from the vineyard.

The 2010 vintage was a long, cool year: our grapes hung on the vine several weeks later than average, and quality was excellent. We finished picking our estate a full week before fall rains arrived, and we're extremely proud of the resulting wines.
