2007 Charles Vineyard "Clone 05" Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

We discovered that one of our estate Pinot Noir clones, Pommard 05, loves new oak. We learned through tasting barrel after barrel of our wines that they just have a natural affinity for each other. So, in 2007, we made four barrels of a Pommard clonal selection, aged in 100% French oak.

The Clone 05 Pinot was produced with the same gentle methods as our other Pinot Noirs — hand-harvested, 80% destemmed with 20% whole clusters, hand punch downs, then fermented with wild yeast and wild ML cultures. No racking was done during aging and this wine was bottled unfiltered and unfiltered.

We love this limited-production wine for its unique spot in our roster of Pinot Noirs — it's bigger and bolder than our All-In or Zero New Oak, but not over the top. You'll taste the toasty oak and spice alongside pure cherry and raspberry fruit — signatures of our vineyard.

Barrel Aging: 50% new barrels, 25% two-year-old barrels and 25% neutral barrels—a blend of François Frèrer and Remond cooperages from Allier, Trancas and Bertranges forests
