

2009 Anderson Valley Dry Gewürztraminer

WINFMAKER'S NOTES:

This Gewürztraminer is an unusual wine for us because it's not from our own estate in Boonville. However, we jumped at the chance to produce a dry Gewürzt from Ferrington Vineyard (next door to our own) because we believe that Anderson Valley is one of the best places in the world for this grape (and besides, a little variety is good for the palate!). So, we created a new label for this non-estate wine, *et voilà*, Foursight now has a Gewürztraminer!

This wine is intensely fragrant, with rose petal and floral notes. On the palate it's dry and crisp with lychee and citrus notes. It pairs very well with falafel, hummus and other Mediterranean foods.
