

2014 Charles Vineyard "Clone 05" Pinot Noir

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

The 2013 Clone 05 Pinot Noir is produced from several blocks of Pommard 05 clone of Pinot Noir grown in our estate vineyard.

It is hand-harvested, sorted in the field and again upon arrival at the winery. Because of the excellent ripeness of the stems this year, we included 50% whole clusters in our fermentations — the most to-date.

Punchdowns were done by hand in small, oneton fermenters, and the wine was fermented with all native yeast and ML strains (we have

never inoculated at our Boonville winery). It was bottled unfined and unfiltered.

Tasting barrels during our first few vintages inspired us to craft a 100% Pommard clone blend, and now we bottle this "Clone 05" each and every year. It shows the beautiful red fruit that Pommard is known for, alongside earthiness and toasty oak.
